Le Vie dei Tesori Foundation is a partner of the EU-funded project “Cultural Heritage fOR AIL: CHORAL”.

The CHORAL project aims to improve green and digital accessibility to cultural heritage sites in Malta and Palermo. The goal is to enhance accessibility for both tourists and residents by developing a joint strategy and installing wayfinding totems to encourage more sustainable mobility. The project also plans to digitize less accessible sites, piloting tools in both regions. CHORAL promotes knowledge transfer, creates sustainable frameworks for digitization, and enhances cultural heritage through greater access and value.

The partnership brings together an interdisciplinary team with diverse expertise, capable of effectively implementing the project's outcomes and achieving significant impact. The project addresses broader issues related to tourist accessibility to cultural heritage sites, identifying gaps in physical accessibility, piloting simple and low-cost infrastructure to encourage sustainable tourism, and developing a joint strategy to improve accessibility for all. Throughout the process, the project also selects sites that are difficult to access for digitization, thus expanding the concept of accessibility and encouraging greater tourist engagement with cultural heritage and places.

The project duration is 24 months (start date: January 2, 2025 – end date: January 2, 2027).

SCOPE

This call for applications is aimed at selecting the following professional roles:

- n° 1 Expert for cultural heritage mapping;
- n° 2 Responsible for disseminating information in cultural venues

N.B.: In addition to the three positions selected, if the number of candidates exceeds the available positions, a ranking of unsuccessful candidates will be established. These candidates may replace them if other eligible candidates withdraw from the position.

TASKS/RESPONSIBILITIES/ACTIVITIES REQUIRED BY THE POSITIONS BEING SELECTED.

The individuals selected based on their various profiles will collaborate with Le Vie dei Tesori Foundation's staff to achieve the objectives of the assigned role.

SELECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE VARIOUS PROFILES

1. High school diploma or equivalent qualification with at least three years of proven experience relevant to the position for which you are applying;
2. Excellent knowledge of written and spoken Italian;
3. Excellent knowledge of major online communication platforms (e.g., Zoom, Google Meet, etc.);
4. Excellent organizational, time management, teamwork, and problem-solving skills. Knowledge of English is an advantage;

The assignment will last 18 months, starting from the date of signing the contract.
